

TRAILER YACHT or KEEL BOAT

The Austral 24 is built in South Australia by Austral Yachts Pty. Ltd. As with its smaller sister, the Austral 20, this yacht is hand laid to the highest possible standards. Its sleek lines give it instant appeal to the racing enthusiast while its roomy interior makes it an excellent cruiser for the larger family. This yacht is exceptionally stable — revels in a blow — is beautifully balanced — easily handled — and has a very safe ballast ratio. The builder provides a full twelve months warranty on hull and deck, Sailaway or Deluxe versions. It is available in swing keel, dagger board or fixed keel.

INTERIOR

- Five full length berths with two cabins separated by a teak bulkhead and teak folding table.
- Cushions are top quality wool and synthetic to your choice of colours.
- The galley is ideally situated near the companionway providing every convenience for the cook. The hinged pop top allows full standing headroom as well as ventilation.
- Ice boxes — two provided, one in the galley and one in the cockpit.
- Toilet — your choice of marine or portable supplied.
- Lights — navigation, interior, switchboard and battery supplied.
- Windows are tinted and fixed with solid chrome plated brass rims bolted through.
- Frontrunner lined walls of hull and roof give an appearance of luxury to the roomy interior and easily cleaned polypropylene carpet on the floor tones in with the overall colour scheme.

SAFETY

- All deck areas are non skid.
- The deck is reinforced with integrally laid balsa core for exceptional strength and insulation.
- The keel is fitted with a lockdown device.
- Self righting — meeting the Australian Yachting Federation requirements.
- 55 pushpit and pullpit with stanchions and lifelines.

RIGGINGS AND FITTINGS — STANDARD

- The $\frac{7}{8}$ anodised mast has 1 x 19 ss wires with adjustable rigging screws, internal wire to rope halyards and adjustable backstay.
- Mainsail and working jib.
- Boom vang and slab reefing.
- Anodised aluminium gunwale with rubber insert.
- Boarding ladder and outboard bracket are fitted.
- Barlow 16 sheet winches. Barlow 15 halyard winch, traveller, turning blocks and pockets for halyard tails are standard.
- Large self draining anchor well.
- SS bow roller, anchor cleats, teak hand rails and fully hinged aerofoil shaped fibreglass rudder with lock up and down device.

COCKPIT

- The cockpit is self draining with room for six adults in comfort.
- Three large self draining bins are provided, one being an insulated ice box.
- All halyards sheets etc. are returned into the cockpit for ease of handling.
- High coamings for safety.
