The spacious interior has 1.73m (5'7") of headroom and six roomy berths, with a separate "Head" area in the forward compartment.

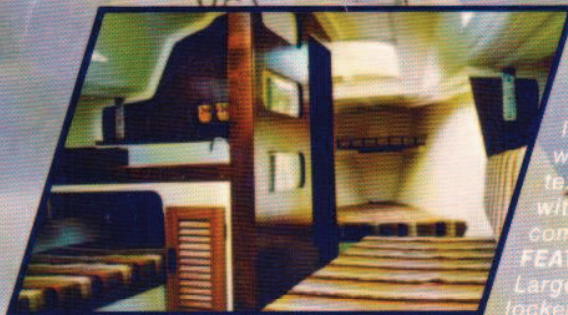
we offer a combination of race-winning performance and ultimate family cruising.

The optional extra of the stainless steel pushpit-pulpit, lifelines and stanchions features also a unique built-in boarding ladder for additional convenience. 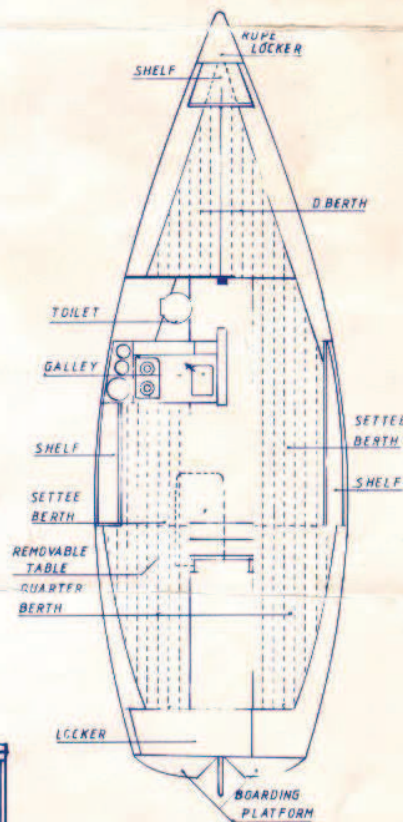
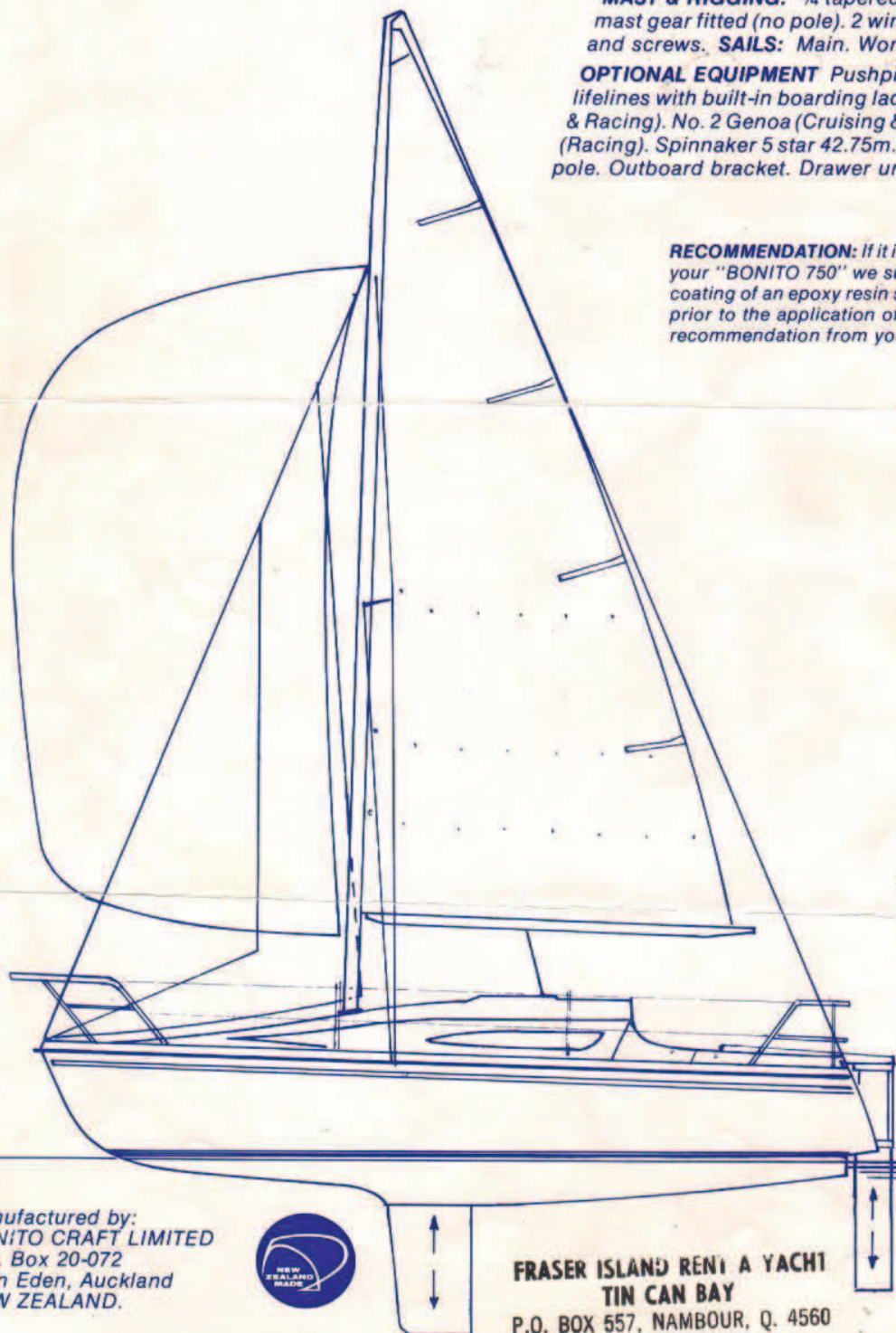

MAST & RIGGING: 3/4 tapered aluminum mast. Spinnaker mast gear fitted (no pole). 2 winches. Stainless steel rigging and screws. **SAILS:** Main. Working jib.

OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT Pushpit-pullpit staunchions and lifelines with built-in boarding ladder. No. 1 Genoa (Cruising & Racing). No. 2 Genoa (Cruising & Racing). Main plus 3 reefs (Racing). Spinnaker 5 star 42.75m.sq. (460 sq. ft.). Spinnaker pole. Outboard bracket. Drawer unit on starboard side.

RECOMMENDATION: If it is intended to permanently moor your "BONITO 750" we suggest an additional surface coating of an epoxy resin system to underwater hull areas, prior to the application of your antifouling. A recommendation from your Dealer should be obtained.
