For yachts being left in the water permanently a new copper impregnated gelcoat is available which eliminates the need to antifoul for up to 10 years.





- Full polyurethene foam buoyancy
- Locking down line on keel
- Drained petrol storage, completely separate from rest of the yacht
- Excellent non-skid surface
- Roller reefing on boom
- Stainless steel safety pushpit makes it easy to pull yourself on board, stops you falling backwards overboard, something to brace yourself against when attending to the

outboard motor, also doubles as a mainsheet traveller to keep gear out of cockpit.
