AT LAST! a trailerable yacht that retains the lines of larger competition off-shore vessels.

A newly designed 5.2 metre trailer sailer.

The ECLIPSE 17 T.S. is a product of the combined skills of designers Ian Lechmere and Peter Joubert.

The ECLIPSE 17 T.S. has been designed as a general purpose family boat but with lively performance.

The yacht includes a great many features more usually found on the option list of competitors.

A bow fitting incorporating fair leads with spring pin and transom corners incorporating back stay tangs have been specially designed and cast, all of which complement the overall lines of the yacht.

In designing the yacht, careful thought has been given to capture smooth deck and cabin lines, a concept more common to larger vessels and not normally found in trailer sailers. In the finished product this blend creates a very attractive yacht.

The aesthetics are complemented further by standard equipment, two-tone colouring and the inclusion of additional, subtle accent stripes.

The ECLIPSE carries a working sail area of 120 sq.ft. comprising a main of 65 sq.ft. and jib of 55 sq.ft. An 80 sq.ft. optional Genoa is available for lively performance in light airs.

The four berth layout comes complete with attractively finished bunk cushions.

Curtains, cooking and other appliances are optional to enable owners to tailor the boat to their individual requirements.

Entry to the cabin is easy via a large opening which extends forward into the cabin top.

An alternative larger than required, forward hatch is also included, large enough for stowing gear and sails, etc.

Included in the price are 2 top quality Meissner headsail winches. They are ideally located to enable simple single-handed sailing. (Halyards also lead to the cockpit).

All up weight of the ECLIPSE is 1000 lb, depending on the final equipment fitted.


Total rigging time is minimal. After just a little practice, owners can expect a total trailer to cast-off time of about 10 minutes. (Ideal for that after work sail at dusk).

The ECLIPSE 17 is designed to cater for family needs and two of the most important of these are low maintenance and operating costs.

The designers have utilized only the best available equipment in rigging the yacht to provide reliable and safe operation.
