The RL28 is one of Australia's largest trailable yachts; (no trailing permit required) and has received remarkable Public acceptance since it was first launched in 1977.

There are now over 100 RL28s afloat in all States covering the length and breadth of Australia ... from Carnarvon to Brisbane and Darwin to Hobart. One was sailed from Cairns to Port Morseby, then on the Lae and will be trailed to Goroka for fitting out by her Owner.

The RL28 is popular also for racing, and has won major mixed trailer sailer events in both sheltered and open waters. However, the boat has been specifically designed for luxurious cruising, and many of our boats are being used exclusively in this most enjoyable way.

It features full headroom, sleeps six adults, and with 550mm (keel retracted) draft and hydraulically operated swing keel, demonstrates an off the beach capability not available in many much smaller yachts.

With full carpeting, (floor and ceiling) and upholstery, a teak dining table, large galley, shower, toilet and wash basin, hanging locker and masses of storage space, . the RL28 has a standard of luxury and space unavailable in other trailable yachts. Although one of the largest trailable yachts, the RL28 is extremely easy to rig, launch and retrieve, as many owners' who use their RL28s for "round the buoys" racing each week end will testing

Equally impressive is the trailing ability of the yacht behind a six cycinder car using our tandem trailers equipped with vacuum disc brakes, as those Southern Stone owners who regularly visit the Barrier to in the Winter morths well know We have trailed our own RL-8 over 50,000 ime. Two others has seen trailed home for Southport in Darwin. Auxilliary power can be provided by a 10HP outbook motor located in the recessed outpoard well, or alternatively, diesel motors up to 15HP can be fitted be the of sh chising enthusiast. We have fitted many volvo sail-drives and they seem wear for the application.

The sheer enjoyment and economy of the RL28 should not be-overlooked, and in most as the need for auxilliary power is confined to short poriods ideally suited to an elec : start outboard motor.

Perhaps the most outstanding feature of the RL28 is the ease with which she can be sailed, and several of our yachts are now being enjoyed by families with no previous sailing experience following a basic sailing instruction with us.

Many are also being used for charter work.
