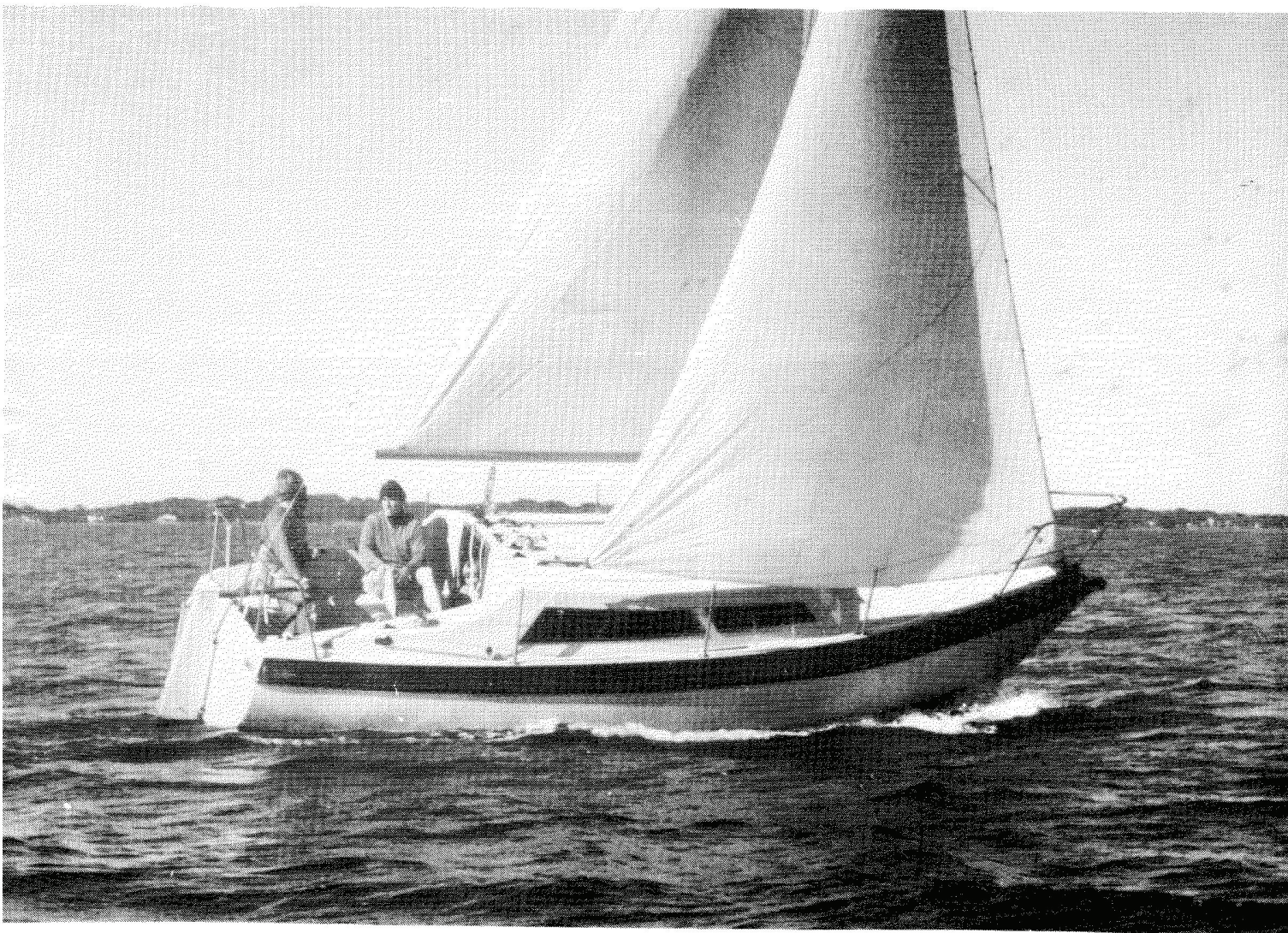

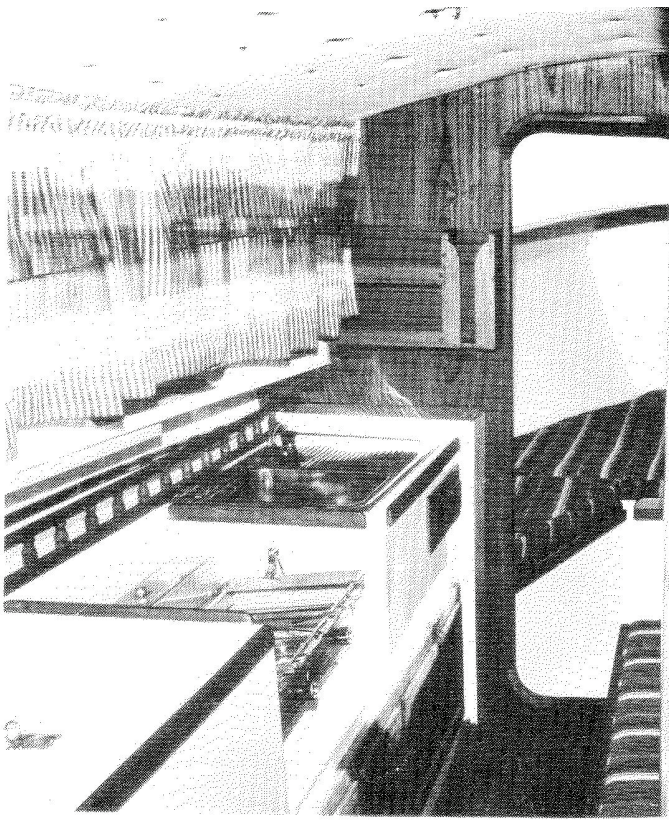
A yacht the whole family will enjoy! Described by leading boating journals as "an amazingly comfortable yacht with a surprisingly good performance, the South Coast 25 is extremely popular with families throughout Australia seeking the convenience, comfort and performance of a large cruising yacht with the budget of a smaller trailer sailer."

The South Coast 25 is available with a fixed keel or a retractable keel that is raised by a powerful hydraulic mechanism. This means the South Coast 25 can be slipped onto a tandem axle trailer with minimum effort — particularly with the long skeg or keel we have designed into the hull bottom.

With an overall displacement of around 1.587 tonnes, the yacht can be trailered by V8 station wagons or any of the popular 4WDs or light commercial vehicles, so the worry and high costs of maintenance on a mooring can be forgotten.

Retractable keels have a particular advantage in the many beautiful estuary waterways so popular with cruising yachtsmen — Lake Macquarie, the Gippsland Lakes, St. Georges Basin — indeed, the Barrier Reef — these are all areas where the retractable keel yacht has an enormous advantage over fixed keels.

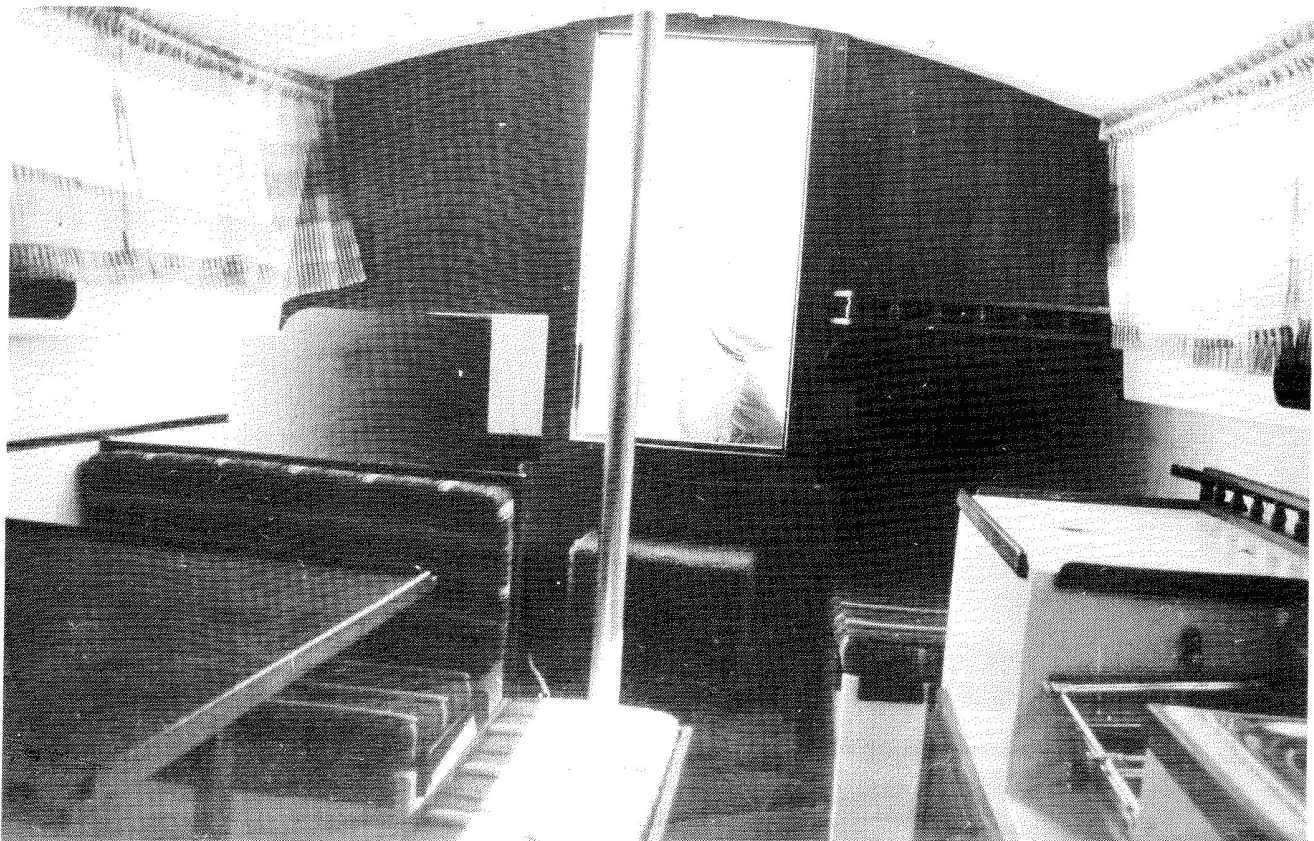

We know you will be happily surprised at the performance — here is a cruising yacht to satisfy the most discerning yachtsmen, a yacht that will point high into the wind, or provide an exciting, fast downhill slide with the wind behind and the kite a'flying! 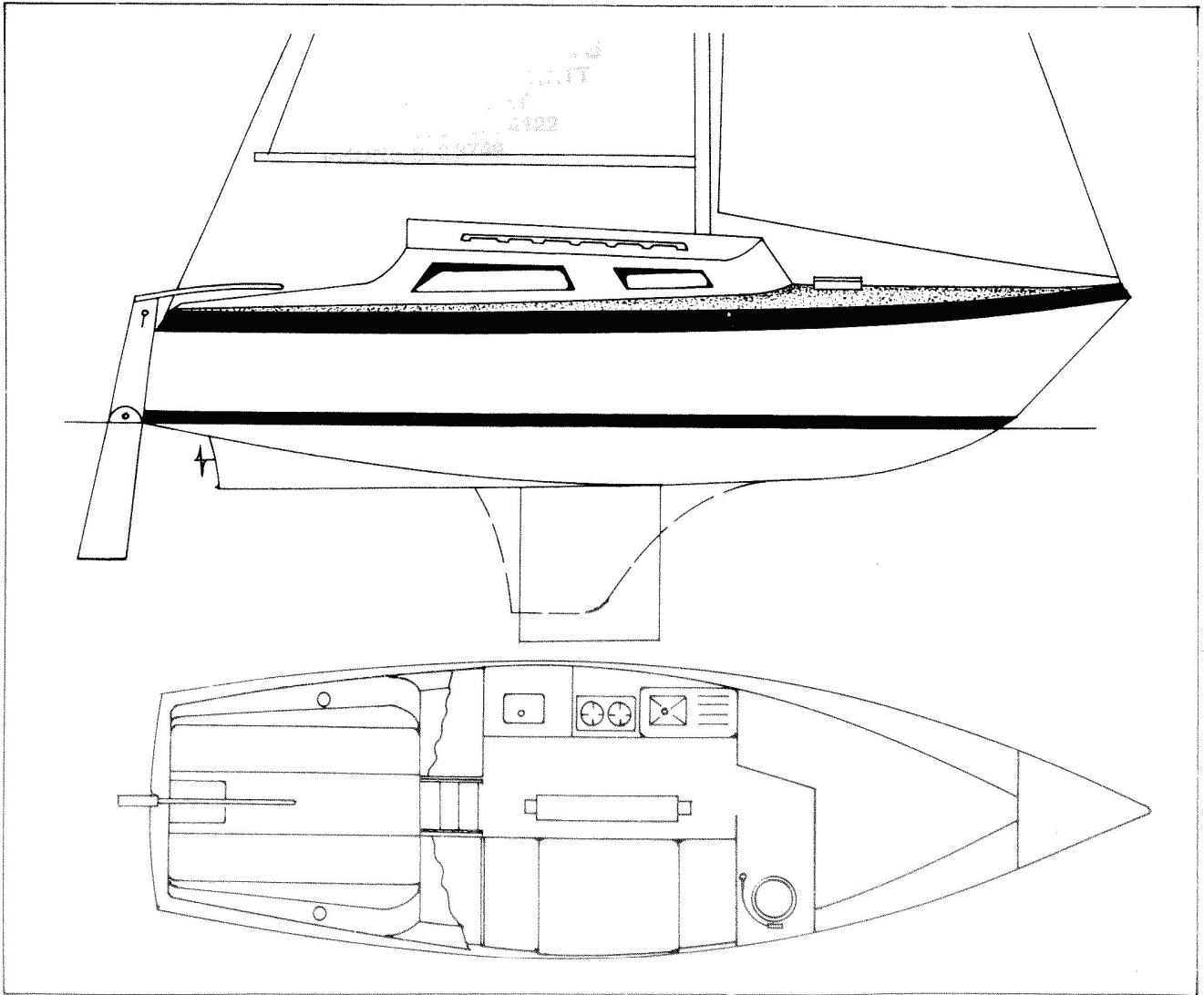
JUST LOOK AT OUR ACCOMMODATION!

Very, very few other yachts can offer anything like the comfort and spaciousness of the South Coast 25. With full standing headroom, (yes, even for genuine 6 footers!), the South Coast 25 will sleep a family of six very comfortably indeed. With two forepeak berths, a large double berth at the convertible dinette and two big, wide quarter berths, complete with the accommodation in the South Coast 25 — but the main design features continue.

Observe how the keel casing forms a very comfortable seat. This means six people can be seated easily around the dinette table. The all important (but too often forgotten) need for privacy at the head is solved by placing this compartment in the forepeak section — and it can be completely enclosed if you prefer. The galley consists of a large moulded fibreglass liner with a big ice chest, provision for the spirit stove and stainless steel sink and storage space — don't worry — the South Coast 25 is designed not just to sleep a family, but to store the provisions and clothing a family needs for an extended cruise.

STAGES

Stage 1: Hull and deck joined, bulkheads and floors fitted, rudder, windows, keel and supports (no hydraulics).

STAGE 2: Sailaway. As above plus front hatch, companionway door, mast, rigging, main and jib, deck hardware, hydraulics on trailable version.

Stage 3: Fully fitted. As above plus interior fitted, bunk cushions, life rails and staunchions, toilet and stove fitted, interior lighting (ex battery).
